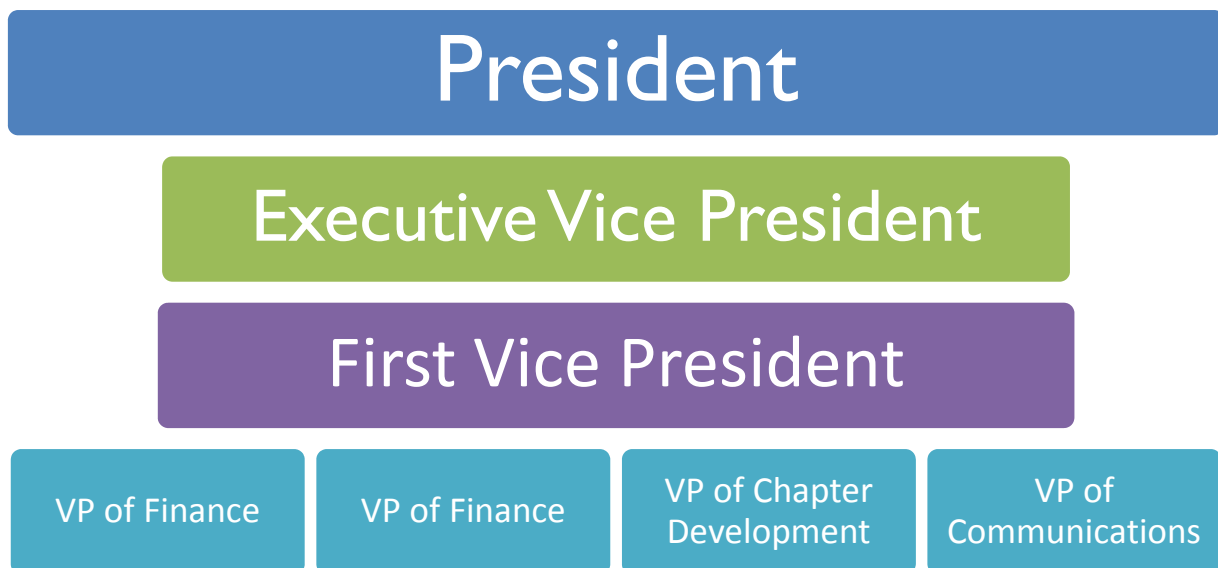
DECA Definition

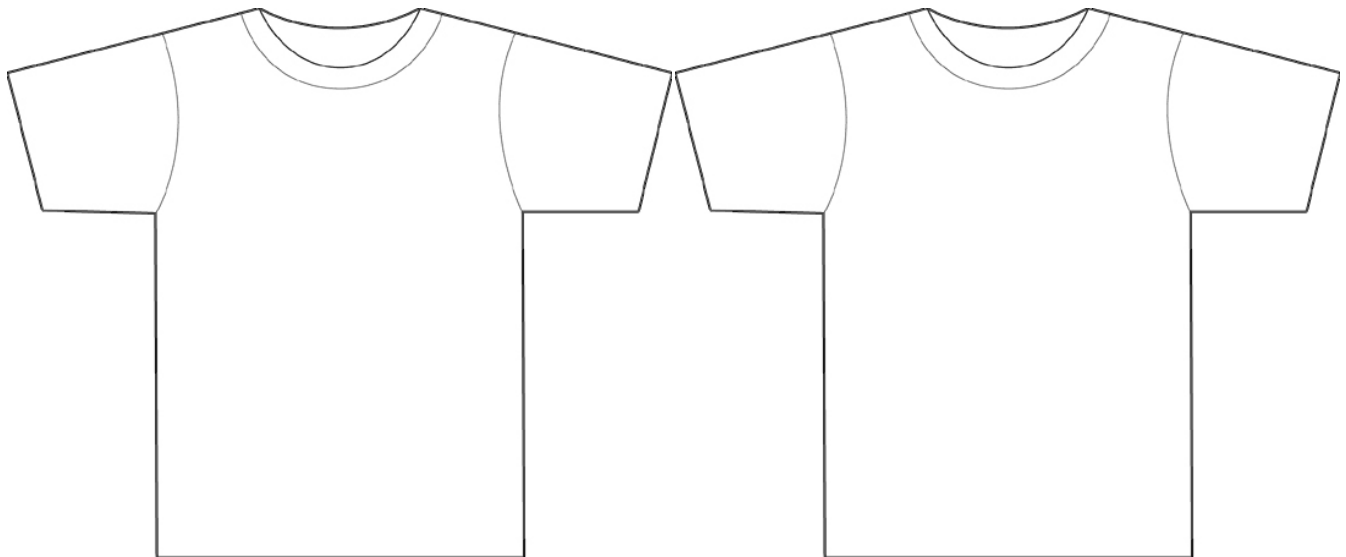
